### Helpful Suggestions:

- BEGIN WITH PRAYER**  
Reading the Bible is not homework to speed through; rather it is a way to connect with God and be in relationship with Him. In order to make this discipline more fruitful, start your reading by thanking God for His Word and asking Him to reveal His heart to you.
- READ EVERY DAY**  
Just as we need food and water every day, we will also grow in our relationship with God when we read His Word regularly. Choose a reading plan that you can realistically keep, and then make it a priority each day. You will have to make time for this, but you will find great joy and reward when you do.
- ENJOY GOD**  
God desires for you to know Him and His love for you. As you read, look for His love and care for you. Also keep an eye out for the big picture, the story of Jesus, God's ultimate gift of love. As a perfect, loving Father, God gave us this inspired book to reveal His majesty and love.
- ASK QUESTIONS**  
As you read, you will come across things that you don't understand, and that's okay. Write down your questions, though don't make them the focus. Mark Twain once said, "What bothers me about the Bible is not what I don't understand, but what I do understand."
- DIARY YOUR EXPERIENCES**  
Consider keeping a journal with you as you read. You'll find many great truths and there will be days when you feel that God is speaking directly to you. When that happens, you'll want to write those thoughts down and reflect upon them. Your interaction with God's Word will nurture your relationship with Him.
